




Traffic Management at Burnside Primary

Picking up and dropping off children Allen Street Procedures



The fence has been removed to allow for increased pick up/drop off areas.

No Parking

DROP OFF PICK UP AREA- ALLEN STREET

This area along the school side of Allen Street has been upgraded in consultation with Transport SA and the Burnside Council. The drop off/pick up area has been extended to accommodate more vehicles.

Please follow the following simple rules.

- Allen Street is a two way street at all times.
- Children should only be picked up or dropped off on the school side of Allen Street.
- Children must remain behind the yellow line (marked on the footpath) until the motor vehicle comes to a complete stop.
- Children can be dropped off or picked up anywhere along the designated area indicated by the new signs. Please collect or drop off at the most northerly position possible. This will keep traffic moving smoothly. Please remain in your vehicle at all times. Leave room between vehicles to allow safe opening of doors/rear doors etc.
- Once you have dropped off or picked up your child, you can wait for the traffic in front to move along or with care you can pull out and continue north along Allen Street. Normal road rules apply.
- There is absolutely NO PARKING in the designated Drop Off and Pick Up Areas.
- There are limitations to parking around our school. Please observe parking signs and do not park in staff carparks.

Picking up and dropping off children at Out of School Hours Care (OSHC)

We ask that you follow these rules so that our children are safe, and we are following regulations.

- Children attending morning care between 7.15am and 8.30am must be signed in by an adult careprovider- not the child or an OSHC worker. This is an official licensing requirement and I understand that parents may not have been aware of this. Students should not arrive at the centre without an adult careprovider in the mornings. Parents/ Careproviders are required to sign the child out, in the afternoon/evening.
- Children must remain within the play areas marked with a blue line (marked on the footpath) when involved in outdoor play. An OSHC staff member is on duty in this outdoor play area. (OSHC staff will wear uniforms so they are easily identified). When students use the grassed areas, there will be with an additional OSHC staff member supervising. OSHC children are not permitted in other areas without staff supervision.
- Parents are reminded that parking is available in the staff car park (entry from High St.) located between the Uniform shop and the Administration building after 5.00pm. The walk way down to OSHC is well lit.
- Vehicles must not enter the school grounds or park in the Stuart St car park before 5pm.
- There is limited availability for parking on High Street during building construction.
