

NETBALL

Competition run by the Eastern Districts Netball Association (EDNA).

Netball is open to boys and girls from years 2 and 7. If we have a mixed team there must be a minimum of two and a maximum of three boys playing.

There are two netball seasons.

SUMMER: starts in term four of one year and is played through until the end of term one the following year. Games are played on Friday nights at one of three locations.

WINTER: Played in terms two and three. Games are played on Saturdays at varying times at one of three locations.

DIVISIONS

Sub Junior 13 years and under, with a minimum age of 10

Primary 11 years and under, with a minimum age of 9

Netta 9 years and under, with a minimum age of 8

Children must turn at least 8 during the year in which they are playing as a minimum age requirement meaning some year 2 students are ineligible to play.

UNIFORM

Sneakers, white socks, pleated black skirt OR black skorts (all players in the same team MUST wear the same style), black under briefs, black Burnside uniform top.

WEATHER POLICY

Summer: If forecast temperature on www.bom.com.au on the morning of the match (ie. Friday) is 35 degrees or above then all Netta and Primary matches are cancelled.

Sub Junior games will still be played however quarters will be reduced by 2 minutes.

Winter: Games are NOT cancelled due to cold or wet weather. Games may be suspended once started if there is hail or lightning.

For both seasons, if EDNA deems that weather conditions are extreme all games will be cancelled with 24 hours' notice.
