Digital Citizenship Guidelines

Looking After Me

- I will only use a device when I have permission.
- I will only go to pages I am allowed to go to.
- I will only share pictures and stories about myself when my teacher or parents allow me to.
- I will talk to my parents and teacher about all of my online friends.
- I will tell my teacher or parents if anyone is unkind to me online.

Looking After Others

- I will only say nice things about people.
- I will ask before I share a picture or story about a person.
- I will only go to pages that are nice and I will tell my parents or teacher if I go to a place that is nasty, unkind or rude.

Looking After Property

- I will not download movies, games or music.
- I will check that the information I get on the Internet is correct.
- I will use all digital equipment respectfully.
- I will not leave rude or unkind messages on other people's spaces.

Parent Responsibility

- I have discussed the agreement with my child and will support my child to be responsible for his/her actions, to practice sound judgement and to speak, think and act with integrity at all times.
- I understand that the school is not responsible for loss or damage to personal devices brought to school.
